

BURGLARS ROB VIRGINIA STORE

Robbers Get Away With a Lot
of Jewelry Valued at
Nearly \$300.

ENTRANCE GAINED VIA
LARGE SHOW WINDOW

Police Have Not Vestige of Clue.
Patrolmen Aver They Were
Not Off Post.

VIRGINIA, Jan. 20,—The store of Sam Milavetz, located on Chestnut street, was broken into at about 3 o'clock this morning and between \$250 and \$300 worth of watches, rings and other jewelry taken.

Entrance was gained by breaking the large front plate-glass window, which was almost entirely demolished.

The police have discovered no clue.

The boldness of the robbery is evidenced by the fact that the store is prominently located.

That the robbery was not seen by the police or the noise of the breaking of the glass was not heard is exciting comment. Both policemen on duty were patrolling the street at the time. It is understood they were at the extreme ends of the street at the time of the robbery.
