

### A Peculiar Case.

Wednesday afternoon M. B. Abeles, of the dry goods house of Friemuth & Abeles, received a letter announcing the death of his father in Germany. The young man was quite overcome by the unexpected and sorrowful intelligence, and at once retired to his lodging apartments on the third floor of the store building, accompanied by a brother who is here visiting him. He had not been long in his room when he fainted, requiring the attendance of physicians who were summoned at once. The efforts of Drs. McComb, Sherwin and Hoyt, however, failed to bring him to consciousness until yesterday noon, nearly twenty-four hours after he fainted. At noon he was roused somewhat from the death-like condition, and it is now confidently expected that he will recover, though at a late hour last night he was seriously ill.
