
DECIDED AT LAST.

The Segelbaum Divorce Case Settled for All Time.

The famous divorce suits of Max Segelbaum vs. Adele Segelbaum and of Adele Segelbaum vs. Max Segelbaum, the complaint in the first suit alleging desertion and in the second cruel and inhuman treatment, were decided in the district court yesterday, when Judge Rea, who heard the cases, filed a decision denying Mr. Segelbaum's petition and granting Mrs. Segelbaum a complete divorce and the custody of the infant daughter Irene. Mr. Segelbaum, however, is given the custody of the son Albert. This decision is made with the understanding that both father and mother shall be allowed to visit the children at any reasonable time. The question of alimony was not decided, but will be passed upon inside of a week.
