

# MUST 'STAY HERE

**A Warrant Issued to Restrain James Butchart From Leaving the State of Minnesota.**

**ANSWER FROM MRS. GILMAN**

**Her Attorney Claims Judge Stearns Granted Her a Divorce From Hugh A. McFadden.**

A short time ago Manson & Edwards got a verdict of \$332.22 against James Butchart as recompense for the loss of a number of logs which were burnt by a fire set by the defendant. The plaintiffs, having learned that Butchart contemplates going to West Superior to do some logging, have secured from the court a warrant to restrain him from leaving the state.

There were fourteen cases disposed of in special session. In the matter of the assignment of Cutliffe Bros., there being no appearance by anybody, the case was stricken from the calendar. In James Middleton et al. vs. Denis Denton, the evidence was taken by the reporter, to be transcribed later.

Krupp & Rink vs. A. F. Swanstrom, order issued for an injunction staying the sale.

L. F. Schumann vs. John Grant, change of venue to Rice county granted.

In the condemnation proceedings of the Duluth & Winnipeg Railroad company vs. Geo. F. McManus, a stay of twenty days was granted.

In the matter of the assignment of Brown Bros., insolvents, the case was continued until Judge Stearns shall have decided the main action involving the rights of D. M. Ferry, mortgagee. Brown Bros. rented to W. M. Prindle the house No. 310 East Fourth street. The latter now has in his possession \$500, rent due for the house, but he has retained it because he did not know whom to pay it to. Ferry, who holds a mortgage on the property, asks the court to order Prindle to pay it to him as part of the interest money. However the court refused to do this, until Judge Stearns, by his decision, has declared whether or not Mr. Ferry is a bona fide mortgagee.

Wm. C. Sargent vs. W. O. Collander et al., an action to quiet title, judgment for the plaintiff. Charles E. Brayden vs. Wm. O. Tillotson, sale confirmed. John A. Coke et al. vs. Wm. O. Tillotson, sale confirmed.

Lewis N. Worthington vs. Anton Skubyzisky, and same plaintiff vs. Dubell, judgment for the plaintiff for possession.
