

STRIPPING CONTRACTS.

Tax Taken By Capt. Stevens—New Town of Eveleth.

Capt. A. W. Stevens yesterday secured a contract for stripping the Lone Jack mining property at Virginia. Twenty five thousand yards of earth will be removed.

Capt. Stevens also secured the contract for stripping and mining the Low more property at Mountain Iron, of which G. A. St. Clair is lessee. The contract calls for the removal of 50,000 yards of earth, and work on both contracts will be commenced as soon as machinery and men for doing the work can be got upon the ground.

Town of Eveleth.

The new town on the Adams Mining company's property in 31 59 17, which is to be placed on the market shortly, will be known as Eveleth. The plat consists of forty acres, and is completely hemmed in by mines.

Engineer H. L. Chapin, who has been surveying the new townsite near the Lake Superior company's holdings, 20 58 19, has completed his labors, and a number of buildings have already been erected, the lumber being toted across from Mountain Iron, a distance of twenty four miles. Notwithstanding the long haul, about sixty thousand feet are arriving daily.
