

BOLD BURGLARS

Two Victims Added to the List by the Gang on Saturday Night

The presence of a gang of burg'ars in Duluth has been known to the police for some time and last night despite the vigilance of the officers two fresh victims were added to the list. The residence of Levin Bros. at 501 West Superior street, was entered through a back door and the cash till was broken open and contents taken. In this instance the thieves only secured \$1.50 in small change, as the bills and larger coin had been hoiked up in the safe.

At K. V. Cohen's clothing store on Fifth avenue west, in the Henderson building the thieves made a much better haul for they abstracted two full trays of watches and other jewelry. The value of the property stolen from Cohen is between \$100 and \$200 and includes one solid gold watch a number of filled gold watches some silver and composition ones. The police have made an "on suspicion" arrest.
