

## ACT OF HOODLUMS.

S. F. SHER IS STRUCK IN THE FACE WITH A HEAVY PIECE OF WOOD.

Last night as H. Carlson and S. F. Sher were driving up Piedmont av. on their way to Moose lake, near Ninth st. a lot of hoodlum boys tried to pull the things out of Mr. Sher's wagon. He got back to protect his property, when a big boy struck him in the face with a piece of wood about as large as a fence post. It cut his face, swelled one jaw and nearly knocked out a lot of teeth. The matter was reported to police headquarters, but Chief Armstrong considered the chances small for finding Sher's tormentors and assailant.

In police court yesterday Henry Santman, who runs a saloon on Third

st opposite the court house, and William Meyer, the Onkota saloonkeeper, pleaded not guilty to charges of selling liquor to minors, preferred by Humane Officer Haskins. Both put up \$20 bail, and their trials will come off this morning. A couple of drunks received suspended sentences, and three were committed.
