
. ANOTHER NEW BUILDING.

A new business block will be built at once at the vacant corner of Superior street and Lake avenue. A building was projected at this corner last year, but was abandoned by the owner of the property at that time. Last winter the property passed into the hands of F. M. Fowler of Chicago, and that gentleman has decided to go ahead with the construction. The previous owner went so far as to put in the foundation for a building, but this will be torn down, as it is not suited to the present plans. A new contract has been awarded for another foundation, and work will be commenced in a few days. The new building will be two stories high on Superior street and three on Michigan street. It will fill the triangular-shaped corner and be one of the most presentable buildings for its size on the street. The construction will be of brick and stone and strictly fire-proof. Mr. Fowler is in the city arranging for the work about to be commenced. He says that it is not the intention to consider the building completed at two stories on Superior street, and that a foundation will be put in which is calculated to support a building of much greater height. It is not improbable that the building may go higher than two stories this summer.
