

# VICTIMS MADE GLAD

Properly Recovered From Burglars  
Arrested at St. Paul.

J. B. Blackie and Harry Cloyd, arrested Sunday by the St. Paul detectives, were arraigned in the police court yesterday, charged with burglary. Rev. Andrew Schroedel of 14 Igichart street, identified a revolver, a watch chain and a handkerchief which had been found on Blackie. William McCaren of 131 N. Fifteenth street, this city, identified the rest of the things found on the prisoner as belonging to him.

The police believe that they have the leaders of a gang recently arrived in St. Paul. Other members of the gang are supposed to be William and Austin Hoban, James Dugan, James Taylor, Joseph Kelly and Thomas Dunford, all of whom are now under arrest. Austin Hoban, Joseph Kelly and Thomas Dunford were arraigned in the police court, charged with holding up Charles Zalk. It is probable that the charge will not hold, but that they will be arraigned on charges of vagrancy.
