"I'll pay \$1 and kill him," was what  
W. E. Shatto said just before he struck  
Joseph Salonowitz on the arm with a  
spade Monday afternoon. He did not  
kill Salonowitz, but there is every rea-  
son to believe that he will pay more  
than \$3 before the police court gets  
through with him.

Shatto was throwing stones at Salon-  
owitz Monday afternoon, and this  
greatly surprised and incensed the un-  
offending Jew. He stoutly remon-  
strated, and asked Shatto what he  
meant by such actions. Shatto made  
the reply quoted, it is alleged, and  
struck Salonowitz with a shovel. He  
broke Salonowitz's left arm. The  
hearing will be held this morning.  
Last night Shatto slept in the county  
jail, as he did not have \$25 to deposit  
for bail.
