

KASSMIR VINDICATED.

But Patrolman Will Never Visit Superior Again.

The cloud that has hung over the head of Officer Marcus Kassmir of the Duluth police force was cleared away yesterday. He was acquitted of the charge of assault and battery preferred by a West Superior woman and will don his uniform and report for duty again this evening.

Kassmir was in a happy state of mind last night. He was confronted with a large array of witnesses in the West Superior police court yesterday morning and the disposition of some of them to swear regardless of truth somewhat alarmed him. The hearing lasted from 9 in the morning until 6 o'clock last night, when Judge Parker exonerated the Duluth police officer.
