

CHARGE IS DISMISSED.

Abraham Zurovsky Not to be Tried For Grand Larceny.

On motion of the county attorney, the charge of grand larceny against Abraham Zurovsky, preferred by John R. Bell, was dismissed.

The case was originally based on allegations that the defendant, on April 14 last, called at the factory of the Duluth Shoe company and purchased \$77 worth of shoes on the representation that he had stock and fixtures at 1521 West Superior street, valued at \$1,000, and that his debts did not exceed \$20. The company's second information led to the belief that grand larceny had been committed, whereupon a prosecution of Zurovsky was instituted.
