

A SOLEMN FEAST

The Jewish Yom Kippur Begins Tomorrow at Sunset.

The great Jewish fast day, Yom Kippur or the Day of Atonement, will be strictly observed by the Jews of this city, beginning to-morrow evening at sunset and continuing until Monday evening. The observance of this, the most important fast day of the Jews, will begin with services by the Hebrew Reform congregation to-morrow evening at 7:30, when "The Jewish Question" will be discussed. Monday morning services will be held at 10 o'clock, the subject being "Of What We Should Repent and How We Should Repent." Memorial services will be held in the afternoon at 4 o'clock. Other services will also be held during the day.

Five days later the Jews of the city will observe the Feast of the Booths. On the seventh day of this feast the Hosanna Rabba will be observed in the synagogue. On the eighth day the festival will come to a close with an observance called the "Rejoicing of the law."
