

RABBI FREY RESIGNS

**HEBREW LEADER ABOUT TO GO TO
LEAVENWORTH, KANSAS.**

**Will Have Charge of the Temple
Bnai Geshurun, at Leavenworth.
Has Been With the Duluth Tem-
ple Emmanuel for Three Years.
Gets a Synagogue Well Started.**

Rev. Sigmund Frey, the leading Hebrew clergyman of the city and rabbi of the Temple Emmanuel congregation, will leave Duluth in a week or two for Leavenworth, Kan. Rabbi Frey will have charge of the Temple Bnai Geshurun at Leavenworth, Kan. The congregation is much larger than that of the Temple Emmanuel and Rabbi Frey feels that the work affords much greater opportunities than does the work here.

Rabbi Frey spoke before the Leavenworth congregation at its synagogue a week ago last Friday and a Leavenworth paper is giving quite a full account of the sermon, says that Rabbi Frey instantly made a good impression on the congregation and received the support of all. On the following Sunday the congregation met and voted to ask Rabbi Frey to accept the pastorship of the synagogue. Dr. Frey accepted and has tendered his resignation to the Temple Emmanuel.

Dr. Frey and his family will leave here soon. They are not certain when they will leave but as Dr. Frey is to take up

his new work on March 15, he will leave by the first of the month.

Rabbi Frey has been in Duluth almost three years. Were he to stay here until March 15, he would have completed that length of time. He came here from Springfield, Ill. The rabbi is recognized as one of the most scholarly men in the city and wields considerable influence ever outside Jewish circles.

During his stay in Duluth Rabbi Frey has done much for the Hebrews here. Among other things he has accomplished is the matter of getting started the building of a synagogue. The structure is not yet built but the lot has been purchased. The lot is at the corner of Seventh avenue east and Second street. The building will begin in a short time.

The officers of the Temple Emmanuel express great regret at losing the rabbi who has gained the high regard of all his flock here. Every effort will be made to fill the vacancy in as short a time as possible.
