

WILLIAM DIXON BUYS A BUILDING

Structure at 20 East Superior Street Goes For \$20,000.

William Dixon, of the firm of Dixon & Lowry, has purchased the building and lot at No. 20 East Superior street from the Northwestern Mutual Life Insurance company. The consideration is \$20,000, and Stryker, Manly & Buck conducted the negotiations.

The transfer is one of the largest reported in business property for some time. The building is two stories high on Superior street, and three on Michigan street, built of brick. It is occupied under lease by the Tom Reed Cigar factory and the Sattler Liquor company.

The premises will be occupied by Dixon & Lowry. They are now located at 327 and 329 West Michigan street, and deal in permanent house furnishings and building materials.
