

AID EXTENDED BY DULUTH HEBREWS

\$300 Raised for Oppressed People in Russia.

The Hebrews of Duluth have responded to the appeal for help from the oppressed Jews of Russia to the extent of \$300. The money has been forwarded to the central committee in New York to be sent to the headquarters of the relief committee at Kirsheneff, there to be distributed where it will do the most good.

At a recent meeting of the Adas Israel congregation in this city a committee, comprising I. Abrahamson, M. Cook and J. Polinski, was appointed to solicit subscriptions among their countrymen, and the members immediately began their work. With comparatively little effort the \$300 was raised, and it was decided that inasmuch as the case is an urgent one, the money should be sent at once without waiting for a more complete response. The members of the com-

mittee state that they are still ready to receive subscriptions, and as fast as they are turned in they will be promptly forwarded. It is believed that if a systematic canvass of the city were made several times the amount already subscribed could be secured.
