

NEWSBOY CAUGHT STEALING PAPERS

Youth Is Locked Up and Fu- ture Offenders Will Be Prosecuted.

Mike Azinsky was arrested early yesterday and locked up, charged with the theft of a bundle of News Tribunes, which he taken from a block on Superior street. A companion, who was with him, escaped.

For some time boys have been stealing morning papers in large quantities and selling them on the street. In one office building where 75 papers are left each morning, the thefts have occurred with great regularity and yesterday a watch was set on the place. Azinsky and another boy were seen coming out with bundles of papers and Azinsky was caught and locked up.

He had 33 papers in his possession. When arraigned before Judge Gearhart yesterday afternoon he pleaded a first offense and was finally released after being given a severe lecture.

The police have determined that this sort of petty theft shall stop and future offenders will be prosecuted.
