VIRGINIA MERCHANT ADJUDGED BANKRUPT Involuntary Proceedings

Brought in the Case of Solomon Rubloff.

Solomon Rubloff of Virginia was adjudged a bankrupt by Judge Page Morris in the bankruptcy court yesterday and Fred Reynolds of Duluth was appointed receiver of his estate.

Rubloff was in the general mercantile business at Virginia and Sischo & Beard, of St. Paul: Simpsom & Co., Minneapolis; McClelland Bros., Minneapolis: Tork & Bros., Chicaro, and

Pitkin & Brooks, of Chicago, his creditors, filed an involuntary petition that he be declared a bankrupt.

The petitioners assert that the bankrupt's assets are less than \$1,500. A meeting of the creditors will be arranged in the near future.
