RABBI DRINKS Carbolic Acid

Mistakes Deadly Drug for Medicine and Nearly Ends Life.

Rabbi Isaac Zeprenblogt of the Su-

perior Itebrew church took a dose of carbolic acid last evening at 7 o'clock, mistaking the drug for a medicine which he was regularly taking. Although the drug taken was concentrated carbolic acid it is not expected that it will prove fatal. The dose was given to Rabbi Zeprenblogt by his wife who supposed she had poured out the regular medicine.

Immediately on discovering her mistake, the ambulance was aummondtake, the ambulance was aummondhospital where he was attended by Dr. H. J. Rene. Other physicians were called to assist Dr. Rene and it is believed that the force of the drug was checked.

At a late hour last evening the Rabbi was resting easily although in considerable pain. The hospital authorities believe that unless a bad turn is taken within the next 24 hours the patient will recover.
