## HEBREWS FLOCKING INTO LAND OF HOPE They Are Leaving Russia in

Thousands Rather Than
Fight the Japs.

NEW YORK, Jan. 12.—The official
records at Ellis island show that for

the first month of the new year immigration to this country is likely to exceed all records.

From the first to the tenth of January the arrivals number over 14,000, also record breaking. For the first ten

also record breaking. For the first can days of the new year 478 persons have been deported from Eills island, against 76 for the same period of time in 1904. of the arrivals during this ten day period, 9,195 were Hebrews. Of the deportations 65 per cent were Hebrews. The arrivals of the Russian and

Hungarian Hebrews in such large numbers is largely due to aversion to serving in the army in Russia.
