

# LUMBER CONCERN ASKS DAMAGES FOR \$631

Demanding judgment for \$631 for lumber sold last May, the W. T. Balley Lumber company yesterday instituted proceedings in district court against Mary Rubloff and others.

The plaintiff alleges that the woman purchased the lumber from her husband, who was the plaintiff's agent. It was used in buildings on lot 7 of block 2 of Buhl and to protect the account a lis pendens was filed against the property last December.

In addition to judgment the plaintiff demands that the property be sold to satisfy judgment and that the defendant be made liable for any remaining balance.

Max Shapiro and the First State Bank of Buhl are also defendants to the suit because they claim an interest in the property.
