

SAYS SHIP'S OFFICERS NEGLECTED THEIR DUTY

Mrs. Gavowsky, Heartbroken Over
Tragic Death of Babe, Reaches Des-
tination at Fargo.

Fargo, N. D., Dec. 1.—Heartbroken from her experience in witnessing the tragic fate of her baby son in mid-ocean, Mrs. Gavowsky, recently of Russia, has arrived here and, with her other two children, is united with her husband.

She was delayed in New York in an effort to have some action taken regarding the Swiss governess who hurled her infant into the sea in a fit of insanity. Mrs. Gavowsky asserts that the governess acted in an insane manner on the trip and had been barred from the first-class saloons and cabins because of her peculiarities. Lack of watchfulness on the part of the ship's officers is alleged and suit may be brought against the company. Mr. Gavowsky was conscripted in Russia for service against the Japs and fled to Fargo, where he had two brothers already engaged in business. He started a store here and has prospered.
