

COURT ASKED TO STOP PROCEEDINGS

S. Koscinski and Wife Allege That Sattler Liquor Company Has No Claim on Their Property.

Stanislaw Koscinski and Mary Koscinski, his wife, have commenced an action in the district court to have the Sattler Liquor company restrained from pushing foreclosure proceedings against them.

The Koscinskis allege that they are the owners in fee of property situated at 2316 West Sixth street and that they signed a promissory note and gave a mortgage on their property for \$700 on the request of A. Lilinski in favor of the Sattler Liquor company, to guarantee the payment of money loaned Lilinski for the purpose of starting a saloon business.

They also allege that the note has been paid in full by Lilinski and that they are not in the debt of the Sattler Liquor company.

The liquor company has commenced to foreclose on the mortgage and the plaintiffs ask the court to have it restrained from doing so.
