

SCHULTZ ENTERS PLEA OF GUILTY

Young Man Arrested for Burglary Admits Robbing Liquor Stores.

Albert Schultz, aged 24, pleaded guilty yesterday afternoon to two charges of burglary in the second degree, after the grand jury had indicted him for robbing the Sattler Liquor company's store on Michigan street and the saloon of Patrick Mulligan, 217 West Superior street.

Schultz has a side-splitting way of criticizing people whose property he has stolen. When he was searched at the police station after his arrest a poorly type-written letter was found in his pocket. It was evidently intended for M. Sattler, and expressed dissatisfaction that the Sattler Liquor company's champagne stock was depleted before he got around.

He also acknowledged his fondness for rock and rye.
