AURORA, May 12.—A new church is now being built by the members of the Catholic denomination, on lots 14 and 15, block I. The building will be 30x40. It is expected that the building will be ready for use about July 1. This will be the first church building in the village.

Joseph Nathanson of Virginia, is erecting a handsome building on his lot opposite the bank. The building will be 30x80 and is expected by Contractor Foss of Virginia to be completed by the first of June.

Max Cohen of Blwabik will also build a structure on his lot facing Jackson street. The lumber has already begun to be handled on the grounds.

Herbert Larson, hoisting engineer of the Miller mine, has resigned and accepted a like position at the Lincoln mine in Virginia. He has already removed with his family to Virginia.

Several cars of steel arrived this week for use on the double track between Colby and Summit. But a very small amount of the grade remains unfinished and when complete the steel will be laid at once.

The Meadow mine which is being developed by G. A. St. Clair, will be a shipper this fall. The D. & L. R. railroad is now putting in a spur which will be about two miles long. It is expected that the mine will be producing when the spur is complete.
