

TWO MEN FINED FOR LEAVING CATTLE IN CAR

HIBBING, Jan. 25.—Peter Karon, a stage driver between Hibbing and Chisholm, and Max Geft, yesterday paid fines of \$5 each and costs in municipal court, for allowing a car of cattle to stand for 30 hours during the recent cold snap on the Great Northern side track here. The men pleaded guilty, but maintained that they had fed, watered and exercised the animals and that they were unable to find a place in which to stable them. Their arrest was caused by Humane Officer Withrow of Duluth.
