

JOHNSON FUNERAL TO BE SUNDAY

Oscar Johnson, the North American messenger boy of Tenth street and Twenty-sixth avenue west who was struck and killed Monday evening in the Northern Pacific yards, will be buried on Sunday next, the funeral services to be conducted by Rev. Mr. Edstrom at the First Baptist church, Nineteenth avenue west, and the burial to be at Forest Hill cemetery.

William T. Johnson, who is a switchman in the Northern Pacific yards, says that the report that his unfortunate brother did not hear the warning of Sigmund Zalk is erroneous.

"Mr. Zalk in talking to me said that he did not warn my brother, but directed his caution to the crew of the approaching engine," said Johnson yesterday. "The statement that my sister Ida is in the asylum for feeble-minded at Faribault is unfounded."
