

# CHISHOLM HAS BUILDING BOOM

Many Store Buildings and Private  
Residences Are Now Being  
Erected.

CHISHOLM, May 13—Chisholm is experiencing unusual building activity this spring and many store buildings and residences are now under course of construction.

A. L. Bergeson has started to erect a building 49x104 feet, one story, for the purpose of a roller skating rink. It is located on the corner of Chestnut street and First avenue.

Sol Rubloff is building a two-story structure near the lake on Lake street. He intends occupying it for his store and living rooms will be rented out in the second story.

Lawrence Kovach intends erecting a brick building next to his saloon on Lake street, 25x70 feet, two stories. The second story will be used for lodge rooms and hall.

D. C. Hackett intends erecting a cottage on Chestnut street to cost \$1,500.

E. J. Casey has started to build an addition to his house on Chestnut street to cost \$1,000.

W. J. Power of Hibbing is talking of erecting a theater here 50x120, two stories, of brick, which is to be located on Lake street and Fourth avenue.

The First National bank will soon commence work on their two-story brick building.

Capt. Lanyon is erecting a fine \$1,800 house on Central avenue and expects to occupy it by June 1st.
