

FIRE BREAKS OUT IN GOLDEN RULE STORE

A blaze of mysterious origin started about 2 o'clock this morning in the basement of the Golden Rule store, 17 East Superior street. The firemen spent considerable time trying to locate the seat of the fire, but on account of the dense smoke, this was almost impossible.
