

HER FUNERAL TOMORROW

MRS. J. D. SATTLER WILL BE BURIED IN THE CATHOLIC CEMETERY IN THIS CITY—BODY ARRIVES TODAY.

The body of Mrs. J. D. Sattler, who died in Duluth Tuesday, will arrive in Grand Forks this morning and the funeral will be held Friday morning at 10 o'clock from St. Michael's church. The funeral will leave the Ingalls house, the home of the mother of the deceased, Mrs. Mary Maloney, at 9:30 a. m.

The announcement of the death of Mrs. Sattler in The Herald of yesterday morning created widespread sorrow. Mrs. Sattler, who was Miss Minnie Maloney before her marriage 15 years ago, was popular with all who knew her. She was 35 years old at the time of her death, and was ill for only a short time. She received her education in Grand Forks, her home for most of her life, attending the University of North Dakota and St. Bernard's academy.

She is survived by her husband, one daughter, Marie, her mother, Mrs. Maloney, sister, Miss Sue Maloney, and brothers Frank and Charley. Mr. and Mrs. Charley Maloney arrived last evening from Winnipeg.

Mrs. Sattler visited here and in Winnipeg only six weeks ago and was enjoying fairly good health.
