

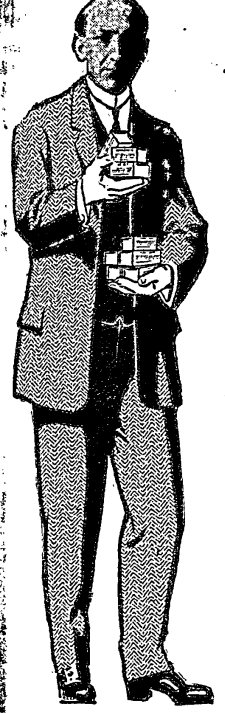

NEWS OF THE RANGES

PUBLIC SCHOOL AT BOVEY. This Building Was Completed Last Spring and Is One of the Handsomest School Structures on the Mesaba.

NO SURPRISES IN THE NEW GEOLOGICAL REPORT

Government in Its Forthcoming Survey Publication Will Not Indicate Many Extensions of the Iron Formations on the Mesaba Range—Disappointment for Homesteaders.

(By a Staff Correspondent.) BIWABIK, Oct. 24.—The records of the United States geological survey, which will be public property in a couple of months, and which will show the result of the field work done by the part of the government to secure accurate information as to the extent and location of the iron deposits in St. Louis county, will not indicate the surprises that have been predicted in some of the scientific and news publications of the country.

No Encouragement for Settlers. It is rather difficult from a hasty view of the map in question, which was really prepared for the government by a geologist employed in the Wisconsin state university, to determine all the changes that are made. It is evident, however, that as a general proposition the government sticks closely to the findings heretofore reported.

So far as publicly known the only reason for the government's change in its outline of the location of the mineral belt in this vicinity, lies in the facts that have been recently announced. Most important of these is the immense prospective mine at the Embarras dam, although the Bangor mine will produce close second when all the ore is taken out. It is estimated that there is 8,000,000 tons of ore at the dam and 10,000,000 tons to be taken out by the underground method.

BUILDING BOOM AT EVELETH CONTINUES

EVELETH, Oct. 24.—While 1908 has been a rather dull year in almost every line of business, the steady progress in home building in Eveleth does not seem to have been interrupted in any marked degree. The largest construction of this year is now being started by D. W. Freeman, W. R. Van Slyke and Slater Borch, who are erecting a three-story room frame residence under one roof and with common walks. The cost has not been definitely fixed, but is estimated to be about \$10,000.
