

BOYS BOMBARD THE KARON HOME

So Ben and Joe Chase the Gang.
Latter Arrests Youth Who Says
He Did Not Throw Rocks.

The home of Ben Karon, 222 East First street, was the scene of wild excitement last night. A crowd of noisy kids surrounded the place and proceeded to make things lively in that vicinity. In the station young Shapiro stoutly maintained his innocence. He claimed to have been two blocks away from the place of the melee. He was locked up for investigation. The boy said he lived at 207 East Second street and gave his age as 14 years. No cause was given to the police for the demonstration.
