# DONATE A CHURCH TO JEWISH PEOPLE

West Enders Will Profit by Public  
Spirit of Hebrew Busi-  
ness Men.

S. L. Karon and L. S. Karon, proprietors of the Northwestern Iron and Metal company, have donated a building to the Jewish residents of the West End, to be used as a synagogue. The building was purchased by them from the Wisconsin Central railway at the recent auction, and moved onto the lot already owned by the congregation at 1513 West Michigan street.

Needed alterations are being made and it is expected that the congregation can move into their new home in a short time.

The building was formerly at Twelfth avenue west and Superior street and is well suited to the purpose for which it is intended. A synagogue has been badly needed for a long time but up to the present there has been no way of securing one.
