

QUIET ELECTION HELD AT GILBERT

**New Board of Trustees Will Meet
Today to Discuss Incorporation.**

EVELETH, April 24.—The election at Gilbert passed off quietly today. There was only one contest, the regular ticket being elected without opposition, except that J. Bonino was an independent candidate for trustee against John Siegel. The latter was elected, the vote being 63 to 13. The election resulted as follows:

President, B. T. Caine; recorder, Frank Bertin; treasurer, M. N. Sweet; trustees, John Siegel, C. H. Matthews, Joseph Prula; justices of the peace, E. O. Welch and John Collister; constables, Charles Murphy and William Dolan.

The board of trustees will hold a meeting at Gilbert tomorrow morning at 10 o'clock for the purpose of discussing the proposed incorporation of the village.
