

CUTS VERDICT TO AVOID NEW TRIAL IN RANGE SUIT

"Remit \$20 of the judgment or the defendant will be given a new trial." This was the decision handed down by Judge Smith yesterday in the suit of the Orbin Stove & Range company against Roy Edelstein. Attorney Crawford for the Range company accepted the ruling of the court relative to reducing the judgment and the case came to a close.

The suit was tried a month ago at which time a jury awarded the Range company a verdict of \$55.92 the amount asked, in addition to the costs amounting to \$30.70. A motion for a new trial was argued a few days ago. The suit had its origin with the sale of a number of stoves to Edelstein by the Range company. Edelstein claimed that he had not been given proper credit for some stoves he had returned to the plaintiff.
