

WHEELMEN UNDER POLICE SCRUTINY

Seven Are Arrested For Riding
Without Light Owing to
New Crusade.

All put up \$5 bail with the exception of Follett and Latts who left their wheels at headquarters to insure their appearance in court this morning.

The chief has issued orders to the officers to be especially watchful and careful during the present week as it is expected that there will be a collection of crooks in the wake of the two circuses and the convention and every effort will be used to guard against them.
