

GRADE PUPILS GRADUATE; GIVE PLEASING PROGRAM

Eastern Section of City Turns Out 275 Students Now Ready for Higher Education—Big Crowd at the Exercises. Western Schools Tonight.

Before hundreds of admiring parents and friends, 275 boys and girls received diplomas last evening from R. E. Deunfeld, superintendent of the Duluth public schools, who represented the board of education, certifying that they had satisfactorily completed the course in the graded schools of this city.

These pupils represent the eastern division of the public schools. Tonight the graduates of the western division will make their appearance at the high school auditorium, where the exercises are held, and will be given diplomas.

The large assembly room in the high school was crowded last evening and many were forced to stand. Throughout the program rendered was an excellent one, and great interest was manifested in each number.

The songs rendered were by a large chorus of girls, and each selection was sung beautifully. The following numbers were sung: "The Heavens Resounding," Beethoven; "O Hush Thee, My Baby," Sullivan; "The Two Grenadiers," Schumann, and "Rub-a-Dub," Vincent.

The invocation at the beginning of the program was read by Rev. W. A. Ryan of St. Paul's Episcopal church; Ruth Wilson, representing the Lowell school, recited "Lasca" stirringly. The Washington school was represented by two boys, George Holzer Stillman reciting "The National Flag" and Robert Thompson giving an excellent rendering of "The Race," from "Ben-Hur."

William McDunough of the Whittier school gave a clever interpretation of "Benedict Arnold." Julian Ritchie, who represented the Lakeside school, recited "The Leap of Roushan Beg" in a meritorious way.

"The Benediction" was rendered beautifully by Julius Nolte of the J. L. Washburn school, and was given hearty applause. Lawrence Richard Duby of the Jackson school interpreted "Haunted By a Song," and plainly made the "hit" of the evening. Glenn Merritt of the Endion school recited "The Storming of Mission Bridge," and John Stacklie, representing the Franklin, gave a short address on "The Mission of the Public School."

The Lester Park and the Jefferson schools were each represented in club swinging exercises, in which both gave excellent exhibitions, showing careful drilling.

Following the program of the evening Supt. Deunfeld gave a short talk to the graduates, complimenting them upon the completion of the grade school course and hoping they would all enter upon a course of higher education. He then presented them with the diplomas.
