## OLD CHAMPS OUT FOR NEW LAURELS

Irving Tigers, With Long Line of  
Victories, Will Be in Football  
Field This Year.

West Duluth is to have a champion amateur football team the coming fall. The Irving Tigers, who cleaned up all the amateur teams in the city in 1905, are reorganizing with the same line-up as in the previous years.

This will be the fourth season for the Tigers. In three years they have not lost a game. Last year the Hummers, another team composed of boys 18 years old, claimed the amateur championship of the city, but the Tigers contested it and won after a game at Athletic park. The Tigers have grown considerably heavier since they first began playing together, and each year they improve in tactics.
