

# GOOD SAMARITAN LOSES HIS COIN

Alleged Hold-Up Artist Arrested  
at Instance of Man Who Had  
Just Bought Him Supper.

Joseph Donovan, a stranger, was arrested by Police Officer Harry Pounder on lower Tower avenue early yesterday morning after he is said to have given Wilton Randall the "strong arm." Donovan was arraigned before Judge Parker in the afternoon on a charge of assault with intent to rob. He demanded an examination and in default of \$500 bail was remanded to the county jail pending a hearing today.

According to the story of Randall to the police, he was accosted by Donovan, who asked him for the price of a meal. Donovan said he was on his way to a restaurant and he invited his new found companion to accompany him. Randall says that Donovan ate a hearty meal at his expense. On going out on the street Randall alleges that Donovan gave him a "half Nelson" and then went through his pockets.

Police Officer Pounder was soon on the scene and he rounded up Donovan as he was running at a Dan Patch clip down through the alley. Randall is also being held at the station house.

Among the other court matters yesterday was a continuance in the case of Louis Karon for a month. Karon is charged with running a motor cycle about the streets at a greater rate of speed than permitted by the city ordinances. It is said that if Karon tightens up the gearing of his machine the case will not come to trial.

Pat Corcoran, charged with "lifting" a pair of shoes from a "dummy" in front of a second hand store, said he wanted to "speak to his attorney" before going to trial and the case was put over until this morning.
