

# THREE COMPANIES ARE INCORPORATED

## Trio of New Duluth Concerns Take Necessary Legal Steps to Transact Business.

Articles of incorporation were filed with the register of deeds yesterday by three companies. The Hartley company incorporated with a capital stock of \$90,000 and will engage in a loaning business, principally upon mortgages and other securities, the purchasing and sale of money obligations secured by real or personal property.

The incorporators are Cavour Hartley, president; Carrie E. Hartley, vice president, Irma Hartley, secretary, Jessie W. Hartley, treasurer and Judith Hartley.

The Moses Montefiore Hebrew school was incorporated by the following: Robert Backman, president; Joseph Pollinsky, vice president; M. S. Cook, treasurer; Charles P. Meyers, secretary; Max Zalk, Louis Helstein, Abraham J. Klatsky, Max Altman and Joseph Oreckovsky.

This school will be a charitable institution for instruction in the Hebrew language and religion, to which all are eligible who believe in the Jewish faith.

Deetz & Co., manufacturers of galvanized iron, cornice material and other metal products, and general roofers, incorporated with a capital of \$50,000 divided into \$500 shares at \$100 each. The incorporators are August W. Deetz, Edward W. Deetz and A. L. Agatin.
