

# RANGE CASES TO DISTRICT COURT

Three Are Appealed From Eveleth  
and Hibbing by Dissatis-  
fied Litigants.

---

Three appeal cases were filed yesterday with the clerk of the district court from municipal courts of range towns. Two of the cases are from Eveleth. In one of the cases A. H. Peterson had been fined by the court \$5 with costs amounting to \$6.50 for assault and battery. In the other he was found guilty of hindering Eugene Maxwell, the city poundmaster, from performing his duties and was fined \$1 and costs amounting to \$5. Peterson thinks he was wrongfully fined.

The other case is from Hibbing, that of Israel Rosenberg against Alex Keller. Rosenberg sued Keller for \$102.95 alleged to be due him for merchandise. A verdict was rendered in favor of the defendant and judgment was given in his favor for the costs of disbursements. Rosenberg appealed to the district court.
