

BICYCLE AND AUTO COME INTO COLLISION

A smashed bicycle and a few ugly scratches on an automobile were the net results of a collision between the two machines on Tower avenue between Broadway and Eleventh street yesterday afternoon about 2 o'clock. Charles Latts, a clerk in a store in the Watkins block, was riding the wheel and escaped with a few bruises and a shaking up, while Dr. George Saunders, in the auto, was unhurt.

The collision was head-on. Latts attempted to cross behind a street car in such a way that he could not see the approach of the automobile and the two came together with terrific force, Latts being thrown to the ground and dragged a short distance before the auto could be stopped.

Latts was able to get up unassisted and walk away. People who saw the accident had turned away with a shudder, expecting that the cyclist would be ground to death.
