

JEWISH AUTHOR DEAD; THOUSANDS AT FUNERAL.

NEW YORK, Oct. 10.—Naphtalia Herz Imber, author of the Zionists' national hymn, who died early Friday last, was laid to rest today in Mount Sinai cemetery with impressive ceremonies.

Although Imber died penniless, ten Jewish societies, all anxious to do him honor, conducted the services today and 10,000 men, women and children trudged behind the hearse on the East Side across the Williamsburg bridge to the cemetery.
