

MISSING BOYS ARE LOCATED AT SOO

Didn't Come on Hamonic; Now
Held for the Duluth
Police.

After several weeks of telegraphing and letter-writing by the local police, and worry on the part of relatives, Frank Lightizer and William Shapira, the latter a son of a local second-hand dealer, have been located at Port Arthur, Ont. They were taken into custody by Chief A. McLellan of the Canadian city yesterday, and are being held subject to the orders of Chief of Police Troyer.

The two boys left Duluth on the steamer Huronic several weeks ago and started to work their way down the lakes. They were apprehended at the Canadian Soo on advices from Chief Troyer and the local police were notified that they had been sent back on the Hamonic.

The latter boat arrived in port, however, without the boys and the chief then started an investigation which resulted yesterday, in the telegram from Port Arhtur announcing their arrest.
