

MAN BADLY POUNDED IS EASY ON ASSAILANTS

HIBBING, April 13.—A row among a number of men in an alleged blind pig at Brooklyn last night was aired in police court this morning. Joe Mozak, who was cut badly about the shoulders and also has a broken nose, was the complaining witness.

Four men with unspellable names were haled into court, and when Mozak saw them and had a little talk with them he was moved by either compassion or fear to relent his resort to the law and instead pleaded for their release. But the case will not be dropped. The men will be tried and punished if found guilty. The trial is set for Monday.

Ben Stone, a clerk, is under arrest charged with assault and battery. The complaining witness is Fannie Jaffe.
