

MRS. JORDHOY ADJUDGED INSANE BY COURT

Mrs. Agnes Jordhoy, 49 years old, wife of Olof Jordhoy, 15 East Sixth street, was adjudged insane at an examination held yesterday before Judge Middlecoff of the probate court. Mrs. Jordhoy has been insane for a number of years and the doctors who conducted the examination believe that her malady is hereditary. She was an inmate of the state hospital at St. Peter from 1893 to 1895.

Mrs. Jordhoy, according to the testimony of neighbors, has been threatening people with death.

She has three children, the youngest of whom is 17 years old.

Mrs. Frank Averbook will be examined as to her sanity this morning at 9 o'clock, a petition having been filed yesterday by the sisters of the St. Mary's hospital. Mrs. Averbook attempted to commit suicide, it is claimed, about two weeks ago, by pouring oil over her clothing and then setting fire to them. She was rescued and removed to the hospital.
