

SOCIALIST ORGANIZER TO DISCUSS CHILD LABOR

A. Litman, the official organizer of the Jewish section of the Socialist party, is in the city and will deliver a lecture tonight at Agen hall on the subject closest to the hearts of those interested in the movement.

The subject of the address will be "The Modern Crime—Child Labor." Mr. Litman has made a special study of this part of the social condition which confronts America today and will produce proofs of the terrible ravages which are being made upon the manhood and womanhood of the country by reason of the non-enforcement of the laws relating to child labor, more particularly in the southern states.

He states that in Alabama and Tennessee it is common for children aged between six and eight years of age to be worked from 10 to 12 hours a day in the mills. He also refers to the sweatshops throughout the north where children work under unsanitary and otherwise indefensible conditions.
