

YOUNG HEBREWS TO HAVE SOCIETY

Meeting Will Be Held This Afternoon at Foresters' Hall, Fourth Avenue West and First Street.

PROMINENT JEWS WILL
ADDRESS THE GATHERING

Social Center and Gymnasium
Features Desired—Membership
of 200 Sought.

A local young men's Hebrew association will be formed this afternoon in Foresters' hall, Fourth avenue West and First street, at 3 o'clock.

Prominent Jews who will address the meeting are: Rabbi Lefkovits, E. A. Silberstein, Max Zalk, Joseph Oreckovsky and Dr. Samuel Gross. Dr. Lefkovits will preside.

The aim of the organization will be to establish a Jewish social center and gymnasium. Quarters will be obtained and reading rooms, exercise and clubrooms arranged.

Those supporting the proposed organization desire a charter membership of at least 200 young men. It is planned to increase this number to 400 within a short time.
