

# Schools Close; Central High Graduates 1914 Class; 490 Grade Pupils Advance

The open season for fishin' swimmin' campin' and other sports for youngsters is on.

It began officially yesterday after Duluth's school children of varying ages were released from the bonds of class rooms for the summer. About 15,000 are enrolled in the city public schools, according to figures of the board of education. Of this number about 250 were graduated from the high schools this week while 490, according to official figures made public yesterday, were graduated from the grade schools.

Clothed in the official gray caps and gowns for the first time in Duluth school history, graduates of the Central high school last night received their diplomas and bade adieu to the school on the hill. R. E. Denfeld, superintendent of schools, presented diplomas to 190 members of the class of 1914.

The class is the largest that has ever been graduated from Central high.

The exercises were opened with the "Alma Mater" chorus by the 1914 class. Rev. John W. Hoffman gave the invocation. The remainder of the program consisted of the reading of original essays by graduates, musical numbers by the Scottish Rite quartet and Miss Vera Bronson.
