## Obituary for Norman E. Evidon

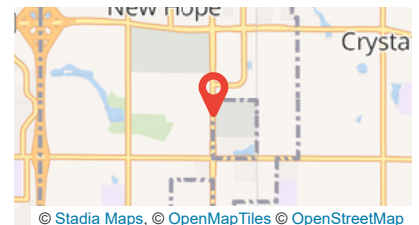
Evidon, Norman E., of Minnetonka, passed away peacefully on July 21st, 2022, leaving behind a rich legacy of justice, appreciation for nature and art, and a beautiful family. 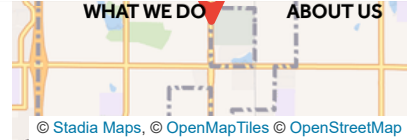
